Background of Jewish Weddings: *Jewish weddings were simple ceremonies followed week long banquets. Normally, the entire village plus out of town family were invited and it was considered rude to turn down an invitation. Weddings must be carefully planned to ensure sufficient food and drink. To run out would be a huge embarrassment.*
