5. Jesus is the Good Shepherd (v28-31)

Personal and Mid-Week Study:

How would you describe these disciples' situation? What might have they been feeling that day?

What does it mean that "they were prevented from recognizing him?"

Luke 24:19-24

What do these disciples understand about who Jesus is?

What did they fail to realize about Jesus?

Luke 24:25-27; Isaiah 53:2-6; Zechariah 12:10

How might Jesus have used these OT Scriptures to explain why the Messiah must suffer?

What other Old Testament passage might Jesus have used?

Luke 24:28-35

Jesus stayed only at the disciples request. Their eyes were only opened to him when He broke the bread. What other moments with Jesus may this reminded them of?

Why do you think they ran the miles back to Jerusalem in the middle of the night rather than waiting until morning?

For Further Consideration and Application:

Has there ever been a time when God was present or His Spirit was at work and you missed it?

Why is it important that we understand that Jesus is the Son of God and the perfect sacrifice for our sins?

When God teaches you something or you experience His work in your life, who do you think needs to hear about it?

Prayer Point:

Pray that you would recognize when God is at work around you. Pray that you would grow in your understanding of who Jesus is. Pray that you would share with others what He is doing in your life.
