Personal and Mid-Week Study:

Who needs to hear your story? How will you go about telling it this week?

What Scriptures would you use to connect God's Word to God's work in your own life?

Prayer Point:

Pray that your eyes may be opened to your sin, to the work of a good Savior, and to how He is working in the lives around you. Pray that rather than being a skeptic or a hindrance to His work, you would be an advocate for those who have experienced God's power.
