Matthew 25:1-13

How can a faith community help each other be spiritually prepared?

For Further Consideration and Application:

What does Jesus want us to understand about being prepared for His second coming? How can we show this urgency in our daily lives?

How does waiting for the Lord's return change how we view life's challenges and our purpose?

After discussing this parable, what new insights have you gained about your spiritual readiness? How will you apply these lessons going forward?

Prayer Points

Pray for a transformed heart that prioritizes trusting in Jesus Christ for your salvation above all else. Seek God's guidance to cultivate a genuine desire for His kingdom. Ask for strength to stay alert and watchful in your faith.
