Read Acts 3:8-11

How did the healing create an opportunity for Peter to share the Gospel?

What role does public worship play in witnessing to others?

Read Acts 3:12-26

What key truths about Jesus does Peter emphasize in his message?

Read Isaiah 1:11-17; Amos 5:21-24; Micah 6:6-8

What type of worship/sacrifice does God actually want? How does that differ from what you are currently bringing him?

How can we effectively direct praise to God in our service to others?

For Further Consideration and Application:

How can we make ourselves more available for God's Kingdom work in our daily lives?

When good things happen to us, how can we point others to Jesus rather than seeking personal recognition?

Read Psalms 34, 41, 103, 147. How do these psalms praise God for healing?
