Read Acts 19:35-41

How did the town clerk's address reflect the political climate of Ephesus at the time?

How does this passage show the difference between proclaiming and protesting? Is there a difference between proclaiming the truth and protesting a lie?

For Further Consideration and Application:

Have you ever found yourself in a situation where faith and culture clashed? How did you respond?

Why is confession and public repentance important for disciples/ witnesses?
