Sermon Notes:

Prayer Prompt:

Thank God for revealing the Gospel to you. Confess any ways you've drifted from grace into performance. Ask Him to deepen your love for the Gospel. Pray for boldness to share your testimony.

Understanding the Text

What does Paul mean when he says the Gospel is "not of human origin"? Why does that matter for how we trust it? (*vv. 11-12*)

How does Paul's former life challenge the idea that religious effort can lead to salvation? (*vv. 13-14*)

What stands out about the phrase "But when God..." in verse 15? What does it reveal about who initiates salvation?

For Further Consideration and Application

In what ways do you subtly add to the Gospel (performance, comparison, guilt, spiritual resume)?

How does remembering that *God pursued you first* change the way you view your relationship with Him today?

What part of your story best reflects a "But God" moment?

Who in your life needs to hear not just the message of the Gospel, but see its transforming power in you?
